Minamisanriku Recovery Market attracted bustling crowds of visitors each month.

With 60% of the buildings in Minamisanriku damaged, most of the town's shops were lost. Business owners took advantage of various subsidized projects and started to work towards the reconstruction of a business environment, helping and cooperating with each other.

Subsidies for group businesses and support for the creation of temporary shopping streets from the Organization for Small & Medium Enterprises and Regional Innovation provided valuable assistance. A number of business people would get together to form a group, pooling their knowledge and formulating a business plan. This provided a foothold for rehabilitation.

Buoyed by such support, business owners who had been on the verge of giving up were able to regain a positive attitude and take on the challenges of running a business once again. Consumers also supported the restoration of a business environment.
